Hello and welcome, overview of agenda for today

We welcomed everyone and went through the agenda.

Lucy congratulated YVEC on a successful Summit and shared some of the feedback received.

Hybrid Facilitation Project Update

- Sarah updated that in March, a small workgroup of 3 YVEC members worked came together to review YVEC's experiences of hybrid sessions, and their ideas for improving them. They chose 3 tools to help make YVEC meetings more engaging for members joining online:
 - **Buddy system** 1.
 - 2. Zoom
 - Canva/whiteboards
- Zoom and the buddy system were pilot tested during this YVEC session.
- Sarah highlighted that the aim of this project is to make YVEC members joining online feel included and equally represented at meetings.
- Sarah outlined the purpose of Buddy system and the responsibilities of In-room Buddies and Online Buddies, developed by the workgroup a few weeks ago



Buddy System



Purpose: Help online YVEC members feel part of team, increase involvement, and add some fun

- · Equal mix of online and in-room members, total of 4-6 per group.
- · Groups (ideally) formed early on the day; members check in with each other before main session
- · Use Zoom break-out rooms for buddy work.

Role of Online Buddies

- · Speak up if a task is boring; alternative options provided
- · Report sound & technical issues at the start.
- · Be fully present, contribute, and participate
- · Camera: Keep camera on if you can; or tell your in-room buddies when stepping away.

Role of In-Room Buddies

- · Ensure online buddies' points are heard and shared.
- Notice if online buddies are engaged and being heard.
- · Allow online participants to speak for themselves
- Share roles equally between online and in-room participants.




Mini training on Zoom / Canva by Sarah

 Sarah gave a quick overview of the Zoom breakout room and whiteboard feature being used today to gather feedback on Summit 2025.

The Pilot Test

- We were unable to fully test buddy system, as all participating YVEC members attended in-person this session.
- After some last minute re-jigging/regrouping, we were able to test Zoom as a meeting platform, and to partially test the online breakout rooms, and shared Whiteboard function.
- Sarah hosted a large 'buddy group' in main meeting room, with Gareth moving into the corridor with his laptop to simulate being the remote/online buddy, joining via a virtual break-out room.
- Lucy and two YVEC members went into one of the smaller rooms, and whilst they
 didn't have an online buddy to join them, they were able to contribute real-time to
 the shared whiteboard, which everyone could see, regardless of their physical or
 online location.
- Both Lucy's group and Gareth were able to access and post on the Whiteboard,
 Green post-its were used for 'what went well at Summit' and red for 'could've been better if...' see insights gathered below.
- Everyone was able to discuss the topics within their own groups, and whenever ready, place their post-it notes on the shared whiteboard for all to see. Gareth did some cute drawings on the whiteboard for us too!

The Buckinghamshire School Awards

- Katherine shared the categories for this year and gave out the short-listed nomination submissions for Primary and Secondary Teacher of the Year Award 2025.
- YVEC reviewed the submissions and selected a winner for each category. See PPT attached. Members were in agreement with the winners!



Pilot Feedback

- We mostly preferred Zoom over Teams for various reasons;
 - o Zoom is more interactive, fun tools
 - Zoom takes up less power than Teams
 - Many YVEC members associate school with Teams whiteboards and prefer the fun and easier to use format of Zoom whiteboard.
 - Some devices can't use Teams, all can use Zoom.
 - o Teams is easier to log into (tech side is more complicated on Zoom).
- Really like the whiteboard as a shared space for everyone to contribute to.
- We tried too many things at once today.
- Needs clearer set-up with Zoom. Give a 'how to use Zoom' guide for people to follow if we're going to be using this in all our meetings. Make it simple and clear.
- Buddy System needs to be cleared up, how it will work with the changing attendance numbers, online and in-person rooms etc.
- The online groups felt included/equal in the activity
