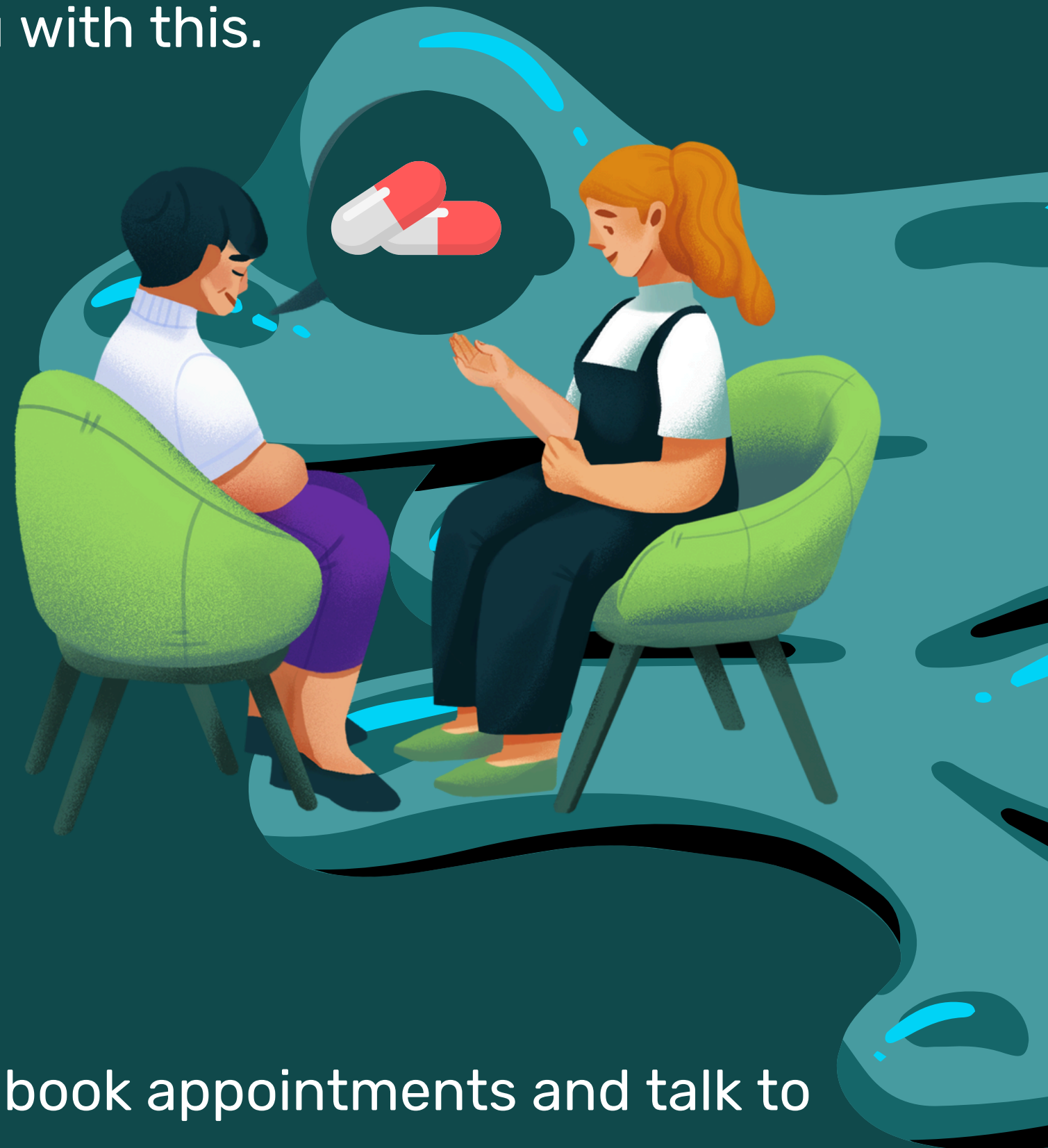
NOT REGISTERED WITH A GP YET?

HOW TO BOOK A GP APPOINTMENT

You can book appointments during your GP's opening hours...

- by phone,
- in person, or
- online



SOMEONE SPEAKING ON YOUR BEHALF?

- An adult you trust can help you book appointments and talk to health professionals for you.
- Due to GDPR, you'll need to give consent when they speak to the surgery.
- You can also give your GP written consent in advance for a named adult to speak on your behalf. You can request a template letter for this by emailing WeDoCare@Buckinghamshire.gov.uk.
